The Victorian Training Guarantee is making training more accessible to people who do not have a post-school qualification, or who want to gain a higher level qualification than they already hold and is an entitlement to a government subsidised place in recognised training that can be accessed at any time. While a person keeps moving up the qualification scale, the Victorian Training Guarantee will continue to subsidise their training.

In 2010, the Victorian Government will assist you with the cost of your training in a government subsidised place (conditions apply), you are still required to cover some of the cost by paying reduced tuition fees.

SECURING JOBS FOR YOUR FUTURE –

Securing Jobs for your Future provides funding for eligible people who are not currently under an apprenticeship or traineeship.

- an Australian citizen
- an Australian Permanent Resident (holder of a permanent visa)
- a holder of a Special Category Visa (sub-class 444, New Zealand citizen)
- an East Timorese asylum seeker, or
- a holder of a Temporary Protection Visa
- a Victorian resident

APPRENTICESHIP / TRAINEESHIP TRAINING PROGRAM (ATTP)

The Apprenticeship / Traineeship Training Program (ATTP) provides people with the opportunity to engage in meaningful employment whilst receiving formal training towards a nationally recognised qualification.

All students involved in this type of funding will be required to be employed under an Australian Apprenticeship and have their eligibility assessed by the Australian Apprenticeship Centre. To be eligible to complete a course with this type of funding support, the Australian Apprenticeship Centre will require you to be:

CONCESSIONS

Concessions are available for study at Certificate I to IV levels for Health Care Card holders studying in a Victorian government subsidised place.

Apprentices and trainees may be eligible for a tuition fee concession at any course level, while Indigenous students always pay the minimum fee in a government subsidised training place.
